## **Eligibility**

- Snowplow Sam through Basic Skills
- Free Skate 1- Free Skate 6 and Advanced Freestyle level skaters (*\*Refer to requirements for Adv. FS levels*)
- Hockey Class (in a number designed just for hockey)
- Skaters must be enrolled in group classes for the **Winter & Spring** sessions in order to participate in the class level number.
- The level of your skater's **Winter** session class (**as of Jan 3, 2022**) is the class level you should register for the ice show, unless told otherwise by evaluation form.

## **Featured Skater/Soloist Eligibility**

- Free Skate 3 & 4 enrolled in class, may sign up as a line leader.
- Free Skate 5 & 6 enrolled in class, qualify for a step-out in a group number (all 3 performances), or a two night duet or trio
- Skaters who have *passed* Free Skate 6 and have a landed axel, will receive a one night solo
- Advanced Skaters with a landed axel and at least one double jump will receive a two night solo
- High School Seniors will be guaranteed a solo spot

## **\*This year there will be no tryouts for solo spots**

In lieu of tryouts and the absence of an advanced Free Skate class, skaters **must meet two (2)** of the following criteria to receive a solo spot:

Skate 3 hours a week of practice ice at Wilmette Centennial Ice Rinks  
Wilmette Resident  
Enrolled in the High School class  
Have a Staff coach  
Passed USFS Juvenile FS test or higher

*Soloist will be expected to participate in at least one group number in addition to their solo*

## **Rehearsals**

Class time is **not** used for rehearsals. (Classes and rehearsals overlap for 4 weeks)

A rehearsal schedule is included in this packet. Refer to it for the scheduled rehearsal times for your skater.

**All participants must** attend a minimum of 3 out of 4 group rehearsals.

Please notify the office or your choreographer immediately, should you have a conflict of any kind.

**FS 1 - FS 4** will participate in their class level group number and the Opening number.

**FS 5 – Advanced FS** will participate in their group level number, Opening number, and Senior Precision

**Dress Rehearsal and Shows are MANDATORY for all cast members.** Promptness is crucial for a smooth run-through. Please allow enough time to put on costumes and skates. The grand march will be rehearsed first so all skaters may stay and watch following their number.

## **Video**

Video recording of the show will take place during the Saturday performance.

Featured Skaters and soloist that are not performing in Saturdays show will be videoed 2-3 hours prior to the 4:00pm Saturday Show.

## **Costumes**

Group number costumes will be ordered by the Wilmette Park District. Fill in the measurements for the skater on the back page of this packet before turning in your packet. Measure generously as costumes do tend to run small. If measurements are at the top of the range, **order the larger size.**

Featured Skaters and Soloist will provide their own costume for their individual featured number.

**Costume Day (optional)** - Saturday, January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 10:00am - 12:00pm. We will have staff to assist you with measuring for the costumes and registering for the ice show.

**Registration / costume measurements and payment due** on or before- *Thursday January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022*

**Any form received after that date will be subject to availability and a \$30 late fee, with no exceptions.**

Your costume order will not be processed until the form is complete and the fee is paid.

**The registration fee includes** your costume, choreography and rehearsal ice-time.

Costumes are made to fit standard sizes; minimal alterations may be needed to compliment your skater. Once ordered, **no refunds or exchanges can be made.**

**Please allow room in your measurements for 4 months of growth for your child.**

*An accurate girth measurement is crucial.*

**All Female skaters** shall wear skating Suntan tights. Danskin, Mondor or Capezio Suntan tights can be purchased at Allegro Dance Boutique in Evanston, Rainbo Sports in Glenview, Body and Sole in Northfield, or online. Other group specific instructions when you receive your costume.

## **Rental Skates**

There is no charge for rental skates during the performances or rehearsals. Rental skates may be taken home for the dress rehearsal and shows as long as they have been signed out by leaving your credit card number and contact info.at the front desk.

**Skaters are responsible for covering rental skates with white boot covers for girls and black for boys, during the dress rehearsal and show performances** (Rainbo Sports in Glenview, or online.)

Skaters in the hockey number do not need to cover their skates.

**Volunteers are needed to assist the staff** in watching over skaters, helping with costumes, hair bows, laces, make-up, calming nerves, etc.

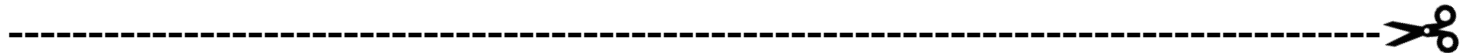
We would like to have **at least 2 volunteers per group** for each **performance**. You may volunteer to assist your skater's group for more than one performance, if you'd like.

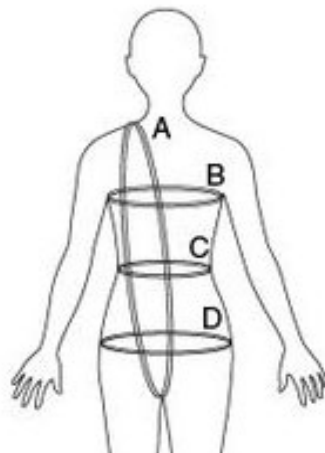
