- You will be prompted for your household username and password

- Fill in information for each child attending summer camp. In prior years, this information was filled out on the Camp Emergency Form
- After entering information for **ALL** of your children attending camp, click **SAVE** before exiting screen.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Afternoon Adventure Camp Full day** begins on **Monday, June 14, 9:00am – 3:30pm** and ends on **Friday, July 2.**
Afternoon Adventure Camp Half day begins on July 6, 11:30-3:30pm and ends on Friday, July 30.
- Starting Wednesday, June 9, the camp director and assistant director can be reached via email at afternoonadventures@wilpark.org. Emails will be checked prior to the start of the camp day and at the end of the camp day and responded to accordingly.
- The ideal camp attire for your child is shorts, shirt, and **athletic shoes** with socks. After camp begins, a camp T-shirt will be given to each child.

CAMP ATTIRE

Camp T-shirts will be distributed the first week of camp. Campers are encouraged to wear their T-shirts as often as possible. Shirts must be worn whenever campers are leaving their regular campsite. Other days, campers should come to camp in loose fitting comfortable clothing to allow for sports/game play. Tennis/gym type shoes are recommended. A swimsuit and towel should be sent to camp each day (weather permitting).

FREE SWIM

Campers will participate in free swim at Centennial Pool once a week, weather permitting. All campers will wear a colored wristband to identify their camp at the pool. Centennial pool staff will assess campers swimming ability on the first trip to the pool. Those campers assessed to only swim in the zero depth pool will be required to wear an additional red wristband. Only flotation devices provided by Centennial Pool are allowed. If your camper is in need of a flotation device, please inform your camp director.

BEACH DAYS

All campers will be given a color wristband to identify the camp they are with. A beach swimming permission slip is included in your camp packet. Please fill out and return to your camp director. Those campers not permitted to swim at the beach will be required to wear an additional red wristband.

SUNSCREEN

Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to drop-off at camp. If a reapplication is necessary or you would prefer that your child apply his/her sunscreen after swimming or periodically throughout the day, please send the sunscreen to camp, labeled with your child's name.

SCHEDULES & SPECIAL EVENTS

Notices will be sent home periodically during the summer to inform you of upcoming field trips or special events at camp.

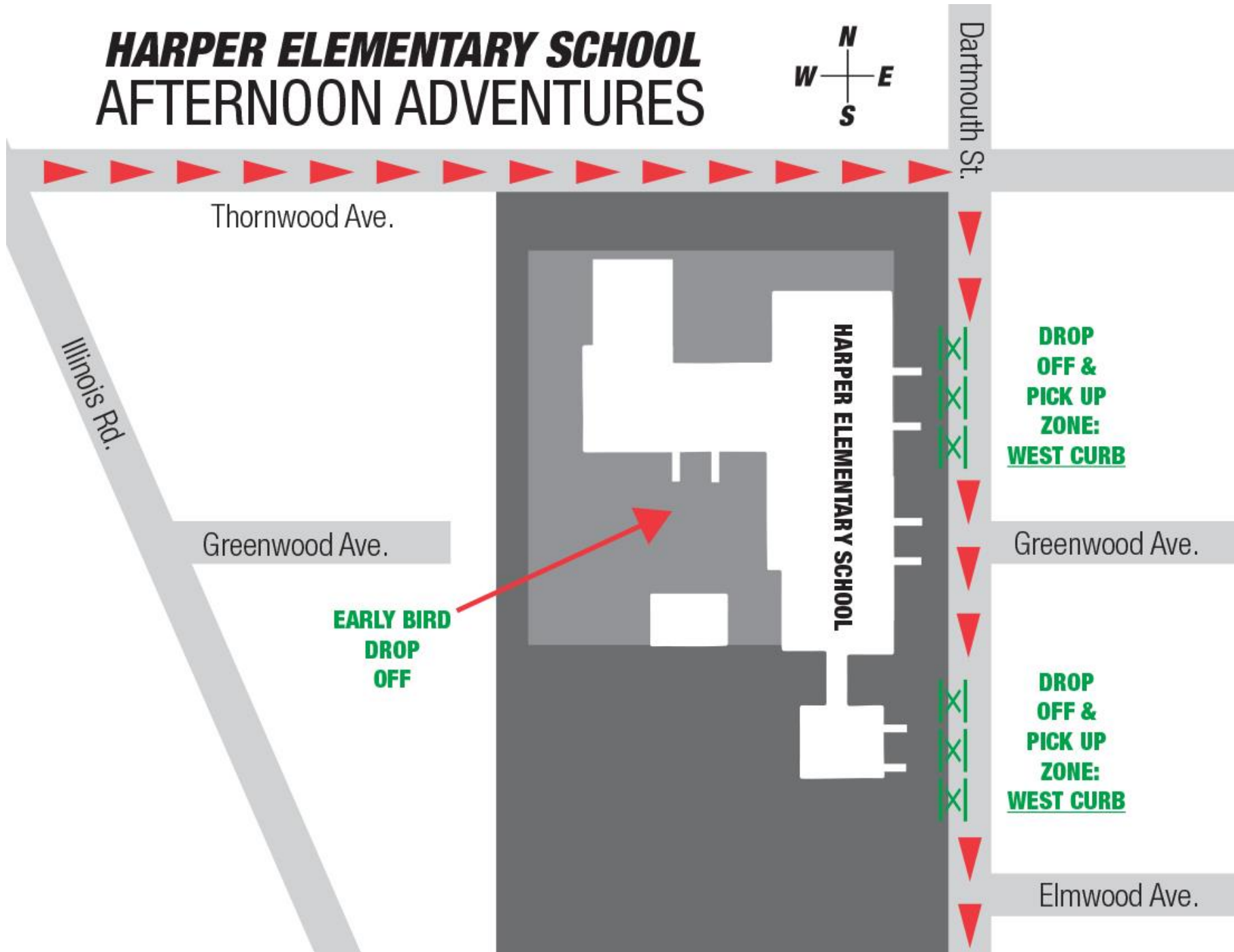
FIELD TRIPS
