Please contact the Lakeview Center for information about camp, to report absences or tardiness, or for any other questions you may have that pertain specifically to Aquatics Camp.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

The counselors will be greeting the campers at **Picnic Area #3** daily, at the south end of Gillson Park. Please enter the park via the south entrance off of Sheridan Road and continue to the drop-off/pick-up location. Please proceed with caution and drive slowly, as this is a park road with many small children and their parents.

If your child is not picked up promptly at the end of camp, parents will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 for every fifteen (15) minutes.

If your child walks to and from camp or rides a bicycle you will need to fill out the attached form for each session they are enrolled in and turn in to the camp director. Children bicycling to camp must remember to bring a lock to secure their bicycles.

RAINY DAYS

Camp will move indoors on rainy days. The drop-off and pick-up location will be at Area #3 unless weather is severe. In severe weather, proceed directly to the bottom of Lakeview Center, accessible via the Lake St. entrance.

WATER ACTIVITIES

Campers will be at the beach each day for water activities (weather permitting). Each day, campers may have the opportunity to swim, kayak, stand-up paddle, use boogie boards, and play beach games. Life jackets will be provided and are to be worn by campers at all times while participating in water activities.

SUNSCREEN

Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to drop-off at camp.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND INSECT REPELLENT TO CAMP WITH YOUR CHILD.

PERSONAL ITEMS

All personal items (i.e., clothing, swimsuits, towels, backpacks, etc.) brought to camp should be clearly marked with your child's name. SQUIRT GUNS, RADIOS AND OTHER TOYS ARE FORBIDDEN FROM BEING BROUGHT TO CAMP. Camp counselors cannot be responsible for broken or lost articles.

MEDICATION

Medication must be sent to camp in its original container. Please place the original containers in a clear plastic bag and label it with your child's name.
