



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. When do I register for CARE, Campus Club, and After-School Clubs?

- 2022-23 school year **CARE After School** and **Morning CARE** program registration is currently open.
- Fall 2022 **Campus Club** registration is currently open. Winter/Spring 2023 registration opens in November.
- Registration for Early Fall **After-School Clubs** opens 8/2/22. Late Fall opens 9/27/22, and Winter opens 12/6/22.

**PLAN AHEAD: Registration for 2023-24 school year CARE and Campus Club opens in January!*

2. What is the length of each Session?

- **CARE After School** and **Morning CARE** run through the full school year with a one-time enrollment.
- **Campus Club** is broken into two sessions, Fall, and Winter/Spring. Fall runs from the start of school until Winter Break, 8/23/22-12/22/22. Winter/Spring runs from the return from Winter Break to the end of the school year, 1/9/23-6/8/23.
- **After-School Clubs** run for 8-11 weeks, depending on the session. Early Fall runs from 8/29/22-10/14/22; Late Fall runs from 10/18/22-12/22/22; and Winter runs from 1/9/23-3/21/23.

3. Does my child need to bring a snack?

Yes! For **Morning CARE**, **CARE After School**, **Campus Club**, and **After-School Clubs**, please send your child with a nut-free snack.

4. Do you offer priority registration or multiple-family-member considerations?

Campus Club families who are enrolled in the Fall Session are offered Priority Registration for the Winter/Spring Session. At this time, we do not offer Priority Registration for **Morning CARE**, **CARE After School** or **After-School Clubs**. We do not offer multiple-family-member discounts.

5. Can students register for both CARE and Campus Club or After-School Clubs?

- If students attend 2 or 3-day options for **CARE After School**, they can also attend **After-School Clubs** if offered at their school on their CARE off days.
- Students attending **Morning CARE** can attend any of our Beyond the Bell options.
- Students registered for the 5-day option at either **CARE After School** or **Campus Club** cannot enroll in multiple Beyond the Bell programs.

6. Is transportation provided to CARE and Campus Club at the Community Recreation Center or Centennial?

- Transportation is provided to **CARE After School** at the Community Recreation Center from the following schools: Romona, McKenzie, Harper, Central, Highcrest, and Avoca. This transportation is provided by District 39 at an additional cost.
- Transportation is provided by the Park District to **Campus Club** at Centennial Recreation Complex from the following schools at no additional cost: Romona, McKenzie, Harper, & Central.

7. Do you offer programs on Fridays with 2:15 dismissal?

Both **CARE After School** & **Campus Club** start early on Fridays to accommodate the earlier dismissal. **After-School Clubs** are not offered on Fridays.

8. Do you offer programs on half days or days off of school?

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

MORNING CARE

Morning CARE, held at District 39 Schools, provides a safe, supportive, fun and interactive experience before school begins.

CARE AFTER SCHOOL

CARE After School is focused on providing quality childcare with independent homework and structured, play-based free time. We will bus your child from their school to the Community Recreation Center for CARE. CARE is available until 4:45 pm or 6 pm.

*If your child would like to register separately for an afternoon Park District program at the Community Recreation Center, CARE staff will escort your child to and from their scheduled program.

CAMPUS CLUB

Campus Club participants rotate through various enrichment classes designed to build life skills and encourage social and emotional development. Specialty instructors lead enrichment classes. There is an option to extend the program until 6 pm to allow for independent homework and structured, play-based free time. Program capacity is set based on ratios for enrichment classes, as well as program space.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

After-School Clubs offer a wide variety of one-hour enrichment “clubs,” ranging from sports to science to music and much more! Families can choose to register for any available club. Clubs are only available to students enrolled at the host District 39 school. After-School Clubs are not guaranteed to run unless they meet their minimum registration requirement. Minimum requirements vary for each club. After-School Clubs are enrichment activities; this is not a childcare program.
