### PLEASE NOTE:

- Pee Wee and Young Sportsters Camp will introduce your child to soccer, floor hockey, kickball, baseball, basketball, football, relays and more. The emphasis will be on the development of teamwork and sportsmanship.
- Camp begins on Monday, June 14 for 5-day or 3-day campers and Tuesday, June 15 for 2-day campers. Session II begins on July 12 and 13.
- Pee Wee Sportsters and Young Sportsters meet at Community Playfields, located at 702 Locust Road, Wilmette.
- Your camper may bring a water bottle with his/her name on it to camp each day. Please refrain from bringing any food items.
- The ideal camp attire for your child is shorts, shirt, hat, athletic shoes with socks, and a facemask. (Athletic shoes avoid injuries and are designed for sports activities.)
- When driving around the campsite, please drive slowly and refrain from using your cell phone or any other form of electronic devices. We appreciate your cooperation in our efforts to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for your child, as well as others.

## **DROP-OFF & PICK-UP**

When dropping off, please pull into the parking lot of the Wilmette Junior High. A staff member will be waiting near the parking lot for pick up and drop off. Please follow the cones when entering and exiting the parking lot. Campers in Young Sportsters and Pee Wee Sportsters will be escorted back to their car at the pickup line. Campers will be instructed to wait with the coach while waiting for their ride.

## **CAMP ATTIRE**

Loose fitting, comfortable clothing that allows for sports play is appropriate. Gym shoes are mandatory, as sandals do not protect feet adequately. Water bottles and hats are also suggested. Clearly label all items with your child's name. A facemask is required to be worn at camp.

## **FOOD**

There will be **no** food served or snacks allowed unless medically necessary. This is to avoid allergy concerns.

## **RAINY DAYS**

If camp is cancelled due to inclement weather you will be emailed at the email on your household account and credited for the day. There is no rainout location for this camp in 2021.
