## **DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES**

The staff will be greeting the students at **the Sailing Office** daily. Please enter the park via the North entrance off of Lake Ave and proceed into the entrance for the Sailing Beach. Please proceed with caution and drive slowly as this is a park road with many small children and their parents.

If your child is not picked up promptly at the end of camp, parents will be charged a late fee of \$10.00 for every fifteen (15) minutes.

If your child walks to and from camp or rides a bicycle you will need to fill out the attached form for each session they are enrolled in and turn in to the camp director. Children bicycling to camp must remember to bring a lock to secure their bicycles.

## **RAINY DAYS**

Sailing Lessons will meet rain or shine. On rainy days, students will spend time learning water safety, knots, sailing terms, and play sailing games on the front porch of the Sailing Office.

## **WATER ACTIVITIES**

Each day, students have the opportunity to learn boating techniques through land lessons and sailing on Lake Michigan. Life jackets will be provided and are to be worn by campers at all times while participating in water activities.

## **SUNSCREEN**

Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to drop-off at camp.

## **PERSONAL ITEMS**

All personal items (i.e., clothing, swimsuits, towels, backpacks, etc.) brought to camp should be clearly marked with your child's name. **SQUIRT GUNS, RADIOS AND OTHER TOYS ARE FORBIDDEN FROM BEING BROUGHT TO CAMP.** Camp counselors cannot be responsible for broken or lost articles.

## **MEDICATION**

Medication must be sent to camp in its original container. Please place the original containers in a clear plastic bag and label it with your child's name.
