Dear Camper and Parents:

Welcome to the **Wilmette Park District's 2021 Sports Camp**. **Camps begin the week of June 14.**

**Camper Information Data** will be collected online through your household account. The information only needs to be filled out once per camper regardless of how many camps they attend. Moving forward it will only need to be updated when there is a change in your camper's information.

- You will be prompted for your household username and password
- After login, you will be taken to the Camper Information Data screen
- Fill in information for each child attending summer camp. In prior years, this information was filled out on the Camp Emergency Form
- After entering information for **ALL** of your children attending camp, click **SAVE** before exiting screen.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- Sports Camp Session 1 begins on **Monday, June 14** for both half-day and full-day campers enrolled for 7 weeks or session 1 only.
- Sports Camp Session 2 begins on **Monday, July 12** for both half-day and full-day campers enrolled for 7 weeks or session 2 only.
- Starting Monday, June 14, the Camp Director can be reached via email at [sportscamp@wilpark.org](mailto:sportscamp@wilpark.org). Email will be checked prior to the start of the camp day and at the end of the camp day and responded to accordingly.
- The ideal camp attire for your child is shorts, shirt, athletic shoes with socks, and a facemask. (Athletic shoes avoid injuries and are designed for Sports Camp activities.) After camp begins, a camp t-shirt will be given to each child. Please put the name of your child on all items he/she brings to camp.

We are looking forward to providing a very pleasurable camp experience for your child.

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**DROP-OFF & PICK-UP**

On the first day of camp, your camper will have the opportunity to meet their camp counselor and fellow group campers. Your camper’s counselor will be at the drop off location to welcome them on their first day of camp.

Please see map at the end of this manual. Please put your car in park and allow the directors/counselors to open and close your car doors. We appreciate your patience with this new procedure. **DRIVERS MUST REMAIN IN THEIR CARS. PLEASE DISPLAY YOUR CAMPER'S NAME ON THE SIDE WINDOW OF YOUR CAR.**

**When driving around the campsite, please drive slowly and refrain from using your cell phone or any other electronic devices.** We appreciate your cooperation in our efforts to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for your child, as well as others.

**DROP-OFF FOR SUMMER SCHOOL CAMPERS**

Campers who attend Summer School may come to camp when their last class is over. By June 10<sup>th</sup>, please inform Stephanie Tandaric, Recreation Coordinator, at [standaric@wilpark.org](mailto:standaric@wilpark.org). Car or Bus drop off will be located at our designated drop off zone and one of our counselors will be waiting to pick up and drop off at your camper’s group location. Please see the attached drop off/pick up map.

**CAMP ATTIRE**

Campers should come to camp in loose fitting comfortable clothing and a facemask to allow for sports/game play. Tennis/gym type shoes are mandatory. A swimsuit and towel should be sent to camp on your campers designated swim day. Camp t-shirts will be distributed the first week of camp. Please put your camper’s name on everything (towel, water bottle, hat, camp shirt, etc.) so that we can return lost items immediately.

**EXTENDED CAMP**

If your camper is signed up for camp until 6:00pm, they will be attending our extended camp option. All campers enrolled in extended camp will be bused to the Mallinckrodt center, 1041A Ridge Rd, Wilmette, at 2:30pm. Pick up will be located at the Mallinckrodt center.

### **FREE SWIM**

Campers will participate in free swim at Centennial Pool once a week, depending on their days of attendance, weather permitting. Centennial Pool staff will assess campers' swimming ability on the first trip to the pool. Those campers who do not pass the swim test can only swim in the zero depth pool. Only flotation devices provided by Centennial Pool will be allowed to be used. If your camper is in need of a flotation device, please inform your camp director. If you do not want your child to swim on a particular day, send a note to that effect and do not send him/her to camp with a swimsuit.

### **BEACH DAYS**

Camp staff will be in the water with the participants at all times. Beach swimming information about your camper was requested in your camp registration. **Camper must wear their camp T-shirt at the beach.**

### **RAINY DAYS**

Camp will meet indoors at Central on rainy days. The drop-off and pick-up location will be the same except under extreme weather conditions, which may require moving the drop-off and pick-up location closer to doors.

### **FIELD TRIPS & SPECIAL EVENTS**

We will not be going on field trips outside of Wilmette but we will be having weekly vendors and special events to replace our field trips. A camp calendar will be emailed to all campers.
